

Biography 2016: Pete Swann, Music Producer/Songwriter/Engineer



Pete started out in the 80's as a rock guitar player in several bands. A Factor-funded instrumental demo recorded at Metalworks studio turned into the theme for Q-107 's Six O'Clock Rock Report. From there Pete went on to write and produce an exclusive music library for Q-107's Rock Radio Network (syndicated weekly national radio show). As a guitar teacher, Pete's students included Adrian and Justin, sons of Rush guitarist, Alex Lifeson.

Currently Pete co-writes, produces and mixes music full time at his studio in Aurora just North of Toronto. Artists include Glass Tiger guitarist Alan Connelly, Hugh Leggat from Foot in Cold Water and Nashville artist Danielle Bourjeaurd.

Awards include the Great American Song Contest (1st place Pop category), Mix 99 Song Contest, Q-107 Homegrown Contest, Radio Impact Awards, and 1st place in the Toronto Guitar Warz Contest.
